Australia is a world leader in marine park management. Parks Australia manages 60 Australian Marine Parks that cover more than one third, or around 3.5 million square kilometres of Australia's marine environment.

Parks Australia recognises and respects the role of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in caring for and protecting Sea Country in marine parks through partnerships with Traditional Owners, custodians and ranger groups.

The North Marine Parks Network is located in offshore waters spanning from the top of Western Australia to the Torres Strait. It is managed through a wide range of collaborations, including western science and Indigenous knowledge, to protect the natural and cultural values of the parks.

This workshop will provide a platform for group discussion and presentations on management activities in the North Marine Parks Network, including:

- Thamarrurr Rangers' marine observations in Joseph Bonaparte Gulf Marine Park
- Dhimurru, Marthakal and Yirralka Rangers' marine activities in and near Wessel Marine Park
- li-Anthawirriyarra Rangers' and Marra Traditional Owners' mapping of Marra Sea Country including Limmen Marine Park and the Ghost Nets Initiative in the Gulf of Carpentaria, particularly ranger-led beach clean-ups.
